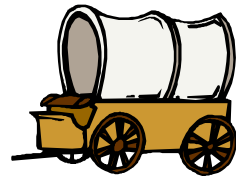


SLINGIN' STONE RANCH

Friday Night Hoedown Help

The Hoedown is a great opportunity to show hospitality to the families from outside of SLC whose children attended VBC. Please **SIGN UP** to help in one of the following areas so that we can make this a church-wide outreach event!

SET-UP 4 HOEDOWN TEAM - Be available to set up tables, chairs, etc. in the tent area on Friday afternoon.

BISCUIT SHOOTER TEAM - Help serve at the dinner.

CHUCKWAGON ON-THE-SIDE TEAM - Be part of the team on Friday afternoon that prepares all the side dishes for the dinner.

GREASY BELLY TEAM - Help the guys barbecue all the meat in the afternoon!

COW HANDS 4 TAKE DOWN - We need several people to stick around and take down the large tent, clean and put away tables and chairs, and clean up in the kitchen.

How You Can Help:

SMALL GROUP LEADER

(Adults and youth 16 or older)

A small group leader serves as a shepherd to a group of 8-12 students. Your primary job is to build relationships with your students so that you can interact with them on what they are learning. Your secondary job is to travel with them to each activity, keeping them safe and helping them to engage in whatever their group is doing. We want to equip you for this important work so we require leaders to attend training sessions. You may choose one of two training options: 2 one hour Sunday morning sessions at 9am (room 233B) on June 13 and June 27 (must attend both); **OR** a 2 hour Saturday morning session on June 26, 9:00-11:00 a.m.

SMALL GROUP LEADER ASSISTANT

(Adults and youth entering 6th grade or older)

An assistant leader helps the small group leader in responsibilities listed above. An assistant must attend one training session on Sunday, June 27 at 9am (room 233B) **OR** on Saturday, June 26 @ 10:00 a.m.

CAMP NURSE

This person would serve the entire week administering basic first aid and following up on campers with issues like diabetes and asthma.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

We need one photographer to take individual pictures of each camper during the first two days of camp. We also need someone to take random pictures throughout the week of camp.

FIRST DAY CHECK-IN

Families need extra direction on the first morning of camp so we need a small team of people to help in this area.

BEFORE CAMP CHILDCARE

(Adult or students 16 years or older)

Some of our workers have early duties and need someone to watch their kids and get them checked in for camp each morning. We need a couple of people to arrive by 8:00 (and be done by 9:00) every morning for this job.

CAMP CHILDCARE

(Adult or students entering sixth grade or older)

Some of our workers need childcare for their children who are not old enough to attend camp. You may serve on this team one or all of the days of camp. This team arrives by 8:30 a.m.

SET CONSTRUCTION

We need people to do some painting on current sets and to construct and paint a simple panel.



CLEAN UP

While the youth do a fantastic job cleaning up certain areas when they are done on Friday, they are exhausted and could use extra help cleaning bathrooms and the lobbies. We can express our gratitude for their fantastic ministry to our kids by giving them a hand in this area! This team would work for about an hour immediately after the close of VBC on Friday.

ONE-ON-ONE BUDDIES

(Adult or student 16 years or older)

Occasionally we have a student with special physical or cognitive needs who could use someone to join their small group and give an extra hand in helping them engage in whatever activity they are doing. No prior experience with special needs kids required but we encourage this person to serve the entire week in order to build a relationship with the student they are helping.
